The OCEB's discount applies to electricity charges incurred as of January 1, 2011 onward. As a result, eligible Summitt Energy customers will automatically receive a 10% discount on their total monthly electricity bill. According to the Ministry of Energy, customers' savings should be at least \$150 a year for the next five years.
